RIVERSTONE RECOVERY RULES (APPLICANT'S COPY)

- 1. Absolutely no alcohol and/or drugs on or off the premises while a Guest in housing.
- 2. Overnight passes are allowed with permission from probation/parole officer.
- 3. Guest are required to sign in and sign out on the Accountability Board.
- 4. Nightly Curfew is 10:00pm. Exceptions are made to accommodate evening work schedules and special circumstances.
- 5. Curfew violations will be reported to probation and parole officer.
- 6. Guests may be asked to take random drug/alcohol test. Refusal to test will be considered "positive" result and Guest will be required to leave immediately. Guest will not be able to return until probation and parole contact with "negative" test result.
- 7. Guests agree to allow management to do random searches of personal property.
- 8. It is recommended Guests do not bring valuables into housing. Riverstone will not be responsible for any lost, damaged or stolen personal property. Lock boxes are recommended.
- 9. If management has to pack and store your belongings because you moved out unexpectedly, there will be a \$20 charge to pick up your belongings. Your property must be picked up within 30 days, or it will be donated.
- 10. All common areas in housing are treated with respect, cleanliness, and sharing.
- 11. No personal refrigerators, microwaves, heaters, furniture, candles or excessive property allowed.
- 12. Any Guests caught stealing will be immediately discharged from housing.
- 13. Riverstone has an open-door policy with Law Enforcement, Probation/Parole, and Court Service Programs. All Guests agree to be respectful to all.
- 14. Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking areas and never in the house.
- 15. There are no Visitors allowed in housing.
- 16. Any type of aggressive behavior toward another Guest or Staff will be immediately discharged this includes bullying.
- 17. Guests are expected to do their daily chore, make their bed, and pick up their personal area before leaving each day.
- 18. Guests are not allowed to borrow money from other Guests or Staff.
- 19. Guests are not to have romantic/intimate relationships with other Guests.
- 20. Guests are expected to be kind and considerate when speaking to other Guests.
- 21. Guests agree to work a program of recovery to better their lives.
- 22. Guests are not allowed to bring pets of any kind into housing.
- 23. Guests should always be friendly and courteous to neighbors.
- Guest fees: \$550/1ST Month and \$500/Month thereafter. If you need help with budgeting and would like to pay weekly or bi-weekly you need to call 985-0052 for prior approval. Payments are Non-Refundable.
- If you will be unable to pay housing fee following your first month's rent, you must inform Riverstone and Parole/Probation officer. Registry requires a one-week notice prior to any moves.
- 26. I understand I am solely responsible to know when my Guest Fee is due and agree to pay on time.
- 27. If a Guest violates any Riverstone House Rule or Policy, they agree to whatever consequence deemed necessary by Staff ranging from 24-Hour *standout to discharge. (*Standout A specified number of days when a Guest is banned from the house.)
- 28. There are no time limits on residency beyond the first month commitment.
- 29. All residents must be on probation or parole and in compliance with IDOC to remain in housing.
